PAOLO BARGIACCHI is **Full Professor of International Law** at the University “Kore” of Enna (Italy). Since 2003 he has taught international and European issues (International Law, European Union Law, Human Rights, etc.) at the Universities of Palermo and Messina and, since 2008, he has held the Chair of International Law at the Faculty of Economic and Legal Sciences of the University “Kore” of Enna, where **he also teaches International Law of Armed Conflicts**. He is a **Lecturer in Master and Specialization Courses at various institutions**, such as SIOI (The Italian Society for the International Organization), Interagency Law Enforcement Academy of Advanced Studies (where he teaches “International and European Security Law”, International Advanced Training Institute for the Prevention and the Fight against Organized Crime. **Member of the Scientific**

Committees of Legal Journals and Ph.D Academic Board, as well as of the SIOI Human Rights Committee, he is also Corresponding Editor for “International Legal Materials”. He is the **author of numerous essays on International law and EU law**, of **three monographs** (on international legal order; on the reform of the Security Council; on the US internationalist doctrine), of an EU Law Manual (in 2015) and, together with Prof. Augusto Sinagra, of a Manual of International Law whose third edition was published in September 2019, by Giuffrè and whose first edition in Spanish was published in Argentina in 2013. Notably, he’s **Academic coordinator of the “Kore” University research unit for the POWERS - Jean Monnet Networks project (2018- 2021)**, co-funded by the European Union. His current main research areas are: Security Council reform; human rights and security; human security, responsibility to protect and EU Global Strategy; global war on terrorism; irregular migration flows and European prevention, management and contrast policies.
